The Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP) allow students to carry out an experience of internationalization. The Erasmus+ BIPs propose to unite students and teachers coming from at least 3 different universities in 3 different European countries in one course. Five students for each partner institution will be selected. The participation in the BIP awards 4 ECTS credits.

The international class will follow lessons partially online and five days in presence in the organizing country (Chieti, Italy). Both online classes and in presence activities will be held in English.

The idea of the proposed BIP 2023-2024 is to stimulate a critical discussion about the evolution of social needs, innovative technologies, ongoing demographic and epidemiological changes that have transformed the way in which we must conceive the social and healthcare network. The recent Covid-19 pandemic has highlighted the limitations of the hospital-centric model and therefore the need for change also towards widespread healthcare across the territory. In fact, the contribution of local structures becomes crucial in the management of health emergencies, reducing the number of non-urgent hospitalizations. In this way, local health services will be coordinated more efficiently and quickly to tend to the citizens' needs.

In particular, students from the four countries will be involved in sharing issues related to territorial healthcare assistance. They will be stimulated to:

- 1. reflect on new models and paradigms for the concept of Community Health Houses;
- 2. draft a design program starting from the comparison with stakeholders and actors of their territory.
