

## Model 1 – PROFILE (Cod.Ud'A 2024/048)

a selective procedure for the recruitment of **one fixed-term Tenure Track Researcher (RTT)** is hereby announced in compliance with Article 24 of Italian Law 240/2010, as amended by Article 14, comma 6-decies, of Legislative Decree no. 36/2022, converted with amendments by Law 79/2022. This position pertains to GSD 08/CEAR-11 CONSERVATION AND HISTORY OF ARCHITECTURE (formerly S.C. 08/E2) and SSD CEAR-11/A HISTORY OF ARCHITECTURE (formerly ICAR/18), and is activated to meet the research and study needs of the Department of Architecture.

- **Date of the Department resolution** identifying the GSD (disciplinary-scientific group) and SSD (academic discipline) for the fixed-term Tenure Track Researcher (RTT) under Article 24 of Law no. 240/2010: Department resolution (CDD) of 04/07/2024 – Protocol no. 58751 dated 24/07/2024;
- **Date of the Department resolution** identifying the profile according to Article 3, paragraph 2 of the University Regulation for the recruitment of a fixed-term Tenure Track Researcher (RTT): Urgency Decree dated 18/10/2024, Protocol no. 80643, and Urgency Decree dated 05/12/2024, Protocol no. 98005/2024;
- **Date of the Department resolution** specifying the weights assigned to the elements subject to evaluation: no specific resolution was adopted; please refer to the ranges outlined in the procedure;
- **Minimum eligibility score:** 60 (sixty) points;
- **Disciplinary-Scientific Group (GSD):** 08/CEAR-11 - Conservation and History of Architecture (formerly S.C. 08/E2);
- **Academic discipline (S.S.D.):** CEAR-11/A HISTORY OF ARCHITECTURE (ex ICAR/18);
- **Specific functions required of the Research Assistant:**
  - **Teaching duties:** The candidate is expected to conduct teaching activities within the History of Architecture and Landscape courses offered by the Department across various degree programs, as well as within the PhD program and other training opportunities available at the University. Additionally, the candidate will be responsible for supervising and guiding students in the preparation of their thesis projects.
  - **Scientific duties:** The candidate is expected to focus their scientific efforts on planning and conducting research related to themes in the history of architecture and landscape, with particular emphasis on the cultural production of the region associated with and influenced by the promoting University, while also encompassing international perspectives. Spanning a broad historical period, preferably from the Modern to the Contemporary era, the research topics will address fundamental aspects of critical studies of architectural works. These studies will examine the works within their historical and socio-economic contexts, exploring their linguistic and technical-structural characteristics, their physical manifestations, and their multifaceted relationships with the surrounding environment.
    - **Third Mission Duties:** The candidate is expected to activate research projects and activities in collaboration with cultural, administrative, and entrepreneurial entities, focusing on areas relevant to the specific research within the scientific-disciplinary sector;
    - **Clinical Care Activity:** Not applicable;
    - **Time Commitment:** Full-time;
    - **Rights and Obligations:** As established by the applicable provisions governing the legal status of fixed-term research assistants and the current Code of Ethics of the University;
- **Duration:** 72 months non-renewable;
- **Salary:** €44,640.92, including a 20% increase equivalent to the remuneration of permanent researchers at the confirmed high class, as required by current legislation. This is in accordance with D.P.R. 12/15/2011, n. 232, and subsequent economic adjustments provided by law.;
- **Maximum Number of Publications:** 12 (twelve);
- **Foreign Language:** Adequate knowledge of English will be assessed, considering the multilingual profile of the University and the academic teaching needs for foreign language degree courses;
- **Mean of Assessment:** Knowledge of the foreign language, or Italian for foreign candidates, will be evaluated through an interview;
- **Funding:** University Funds, as specified in the resolution of the Administration Council dated 30/07/2024 and approved by the Financial Area;
- **Specific Research Activity:** The research will focus on the project: "*Cataloging and critical analysis of the Baroque architectural heritage in the Abruzzo area.*";
- **Scientific Production Objectives:** publication of at least 4 papers, preferably in Class A scientific journals and participation as a presenter in at least 3 national or international conferences;

- **Mean of Assessment of Scientific Qualification:** Evaluation will be conducted through the assessment of qualifications, curriculum, scientific production, and an interview, in accordance with and for the purposes of Article 24 of Law no. 240/2010.
