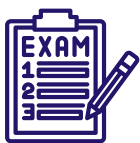


## Credit system

The **Italian university credit system** is based on credit units called **CFU**. The system is based on the concept of “workload”, and is equivalent to the ECTS credit system.

**One university credit (CFU)** normally corresponds to **25 hours of work**, including both lessons and self-study.

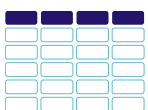
The **average annual workload of a full-time** student corresponds to **60 credits**.



## Grading system

**Written** and **oral examinations** in Italy are graded on a **0-30 scale** (“thirtieths”).

The **minimum grade to pass** an examination is **18/30** and the **maximum grade** is **30/30**. “**30 e lode**” (“cum laude”) corresponds to **full mark with distinction**.
