Modes of Transportation

To facilitate mobility between the dormitories, the university campus, and the city, **bicycles** are available for rent at **Campus Circuito 71** (Via del Circuito, 71, 65121 Pescara PE) and **Campus Jacques Delors** (Strada Comunale Piana, 98, 65129 Pescara PE) at a cost of **€15 per week**.
