Objectives and Description	The research in the fields of Urban Morphology and Building Typology in the last 50 years has considered primarily the "form of the built environment". Most recently, designers seem to have similar approaches in designing public spaces by considering above all the "form of buildings", conceived as standalone objects, and therefore incapable of establishing meaning and form relationships with the landscape. We should also reconsider the impact of "the void's form" on the quality of life, on the inhabitants, and on the climatic aspects of the contemporary city. This Blended Intensive Programme intends to reconsider the Form of Public Spaces, (squares, gardens, parks, and streets) within the Contemporary City by applying the morphological analysis methods to selected meaningful cases, and through experimental design experiences.		
Methods and outcomes	Methods: The BIP " Form of Urban Voids " is a design workshop organised by the Architecture Department of "G. D'Annunzio" University of Chieti-Pescara. It will consider analytically the form of Contemporary Public Urban Spaces. We organised the BIP in the same days of the annual		

	Architecture Summer School 2026. The BIP will constitute an experimental research-based design training. We will define specific design areas and topics in coordination with the Municipality of Pescara and the other participating Universities. During the Blended Intensive Programme, the participant researchers will address the students with Lectures and Seminars as well as by leading small design teams and reviewing the outcomes. This BIP intends to be the first of a series of BIPs, planned in cooperation with the other participating Universities, throughout a 2 year coordinated programme, aimed at preparing the joint application for a funded research on related topics (Erasmus Plus, Erasmus Mundus, Horizon 2030) Learning Outcomes: Understand the formation processes of urban voids as public spaces Analyse the morphological and aesthetical aspects of urban voids as public spaces Comprehend the social and climatic aspects of urban voids as public spaces Apply the identified processes and aspects to the design of urban voids as public spaces Implement sustainable actions in order to improve the climatic aspects of public spaces Research outcomes: Compare meaningful European case studies of Urban Public Spaces Analyse the morphological characters of Urban Public Spaces Correlate the morphological, aesthetical, social, and climatic parameters of Urban Public Spaces Define morphological research-based guidelines for the sustainable design of Urban Public Spaces Define evidence-based design strategies enhancing the resilience and inclusivity of public spaces while respecting their historical morphological evolution

The "D. Brescia" Botanical Garden and "Aromatica d'Abruzzo".

Meet with Majambiente guides at the parking lot of the D. Brescia Botanical Garden in Sant'Eufemia a Maiella. Guided tour of the garden owned by the Maiella National Park and managed by Majambiente. The area, which extends over 4 hectares of land at the foot of the Maiella and Morrone mountains and at almost 1,000 meters above sea level, is home to over 550 species, almost exclusively endemic to Italian flora. The tour will allow us to learn more about the plants, their interactions, their histories, interesting facts, and their medicinal and traditional uses. Finally, a visit to the "Aromatica d'Abruzzo" exhibition is included: an olfactory/sensory journey dedicated to medicinal plants, their properties, and their uses throughout the history of Abruzzo.

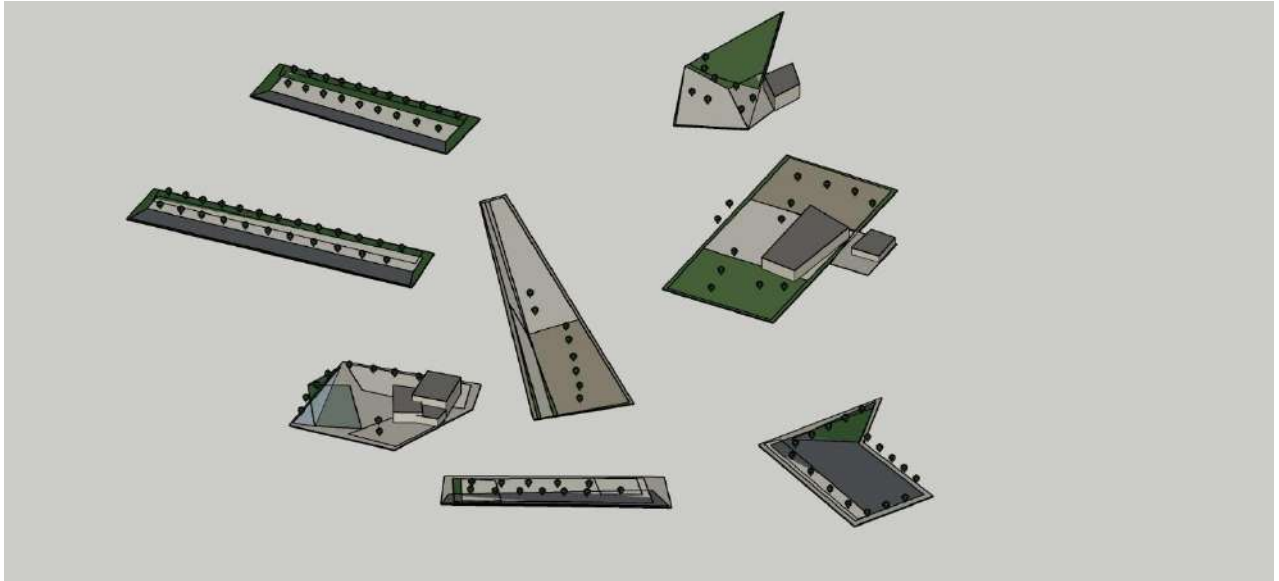

Design Assignment:

During the workshop, students will be organised into groups of five or six and assigned to international tutors. Each group will select one of the eight proposed squares and independently plan a site visit. Throughout the workshop, teams will develop a design proposal for the transformation of their selected public space, placing particular emphasis on urban forestation and de-paving strategies to mitigate the effects of the Urban Heat

Island (UHI) phenomenon. Each team will present its project on Saturday afternoon and produce an exhibition and publication panel using the provided template.



Submission:

Each student team should submit **a power point** (using the template provided in the shared folder/templates), **one A1 printed vertical poster** (using the template provided in the shared folder/templates), a **2 page max text report in word** format (using the template provided in the shared drive/templates), and a **physical cardboard model**, 59,4x59,4 cm.

In the power points students can include all the drawings they have created, analyses, photos, sketches, final plans, sections, 3d model renderings etc.

In the Poster, each team should include only the following publication quality drawings:

- 1 master plan scale 1:500 and or 1:200 with shadows,
- 1 section/elevation same scale,
- 1 large bird's eye view from above of the 3D digital model,
- 3/4 renderings human eye height of the digital model.

The posters and the models will be presented in an exhibition, the power points will be presented in the presentation session.

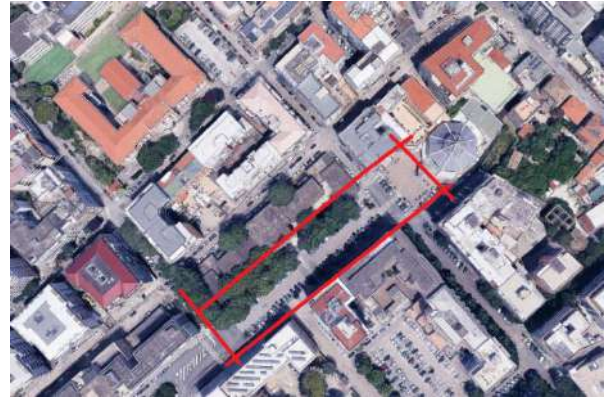
