Pescara is a modern city on the Adriatic sea, the biggest city of Abruzzo, famous for being the hometown of Gabriele D'Annunzio, one of the most important Italian poets of the last century. Pescara is a very liveable city, with good public transportation and connections with the rest of the country and the world thanks to the airport, the railway station and the interregional bus transportation. The life cost is also very affordable for the students who choose to study at University of Chieti and Pescara "Gabriele D'Annunzio".

The "Gabriele d'Annunzio" University, established in 1965 as a 'Libera Università' (non state-owned university), became state-owned in 1982. Today, it has 13 Departments and 2 Schools. There are two university campuses: one in **Chieti**, where the registered office of the university is located, along with the Rector's and General Directorate's office, and **Pescara**. How you can reach us

FROM THE AIRPORT (PESCARA) TO THE UNIVERSITY IN PESCARA:

30 minutes:

- Walk from the airport to VIA TIBURTINA VALERIA (bus stop n. 307)
- Take the bus called "PESCARA VIA CHIETI SCALO", you have to get off the bus in "PIAZZALE REPUBBLICA-TERMINAL BUS"
- Take the bus called "PESCARA-ORTONA" and get off the bus in "VIALE GUGLIELMO MARCONI 122"
- From there, 3 minutes walking to get to the University.

Or

- Walk from the airport to VIA CAMILLO BENSO CONTE DI CAVOUR 16 (13 min)
- Take the bus n. 6 for "SAMBUCETO-MONTESILVANO" and get off the bus in "università"
- The University will be a few minutes on foot from there.

GENERAL INFO 5

FROM THE CENTRAL STATION OF PESCARA TO THE UNIVERSITY IN PESCARA:

16-20 minutes:

- Walk from the station to PIAZZALE REPUBBLICA- TERMINAL BUS (4 min)
- Take the bus n. **Z** for "SAN SILVESTRO" and get off the bus in "UNIVERSITÀ-TRIBUNALE" (10 min)

Or

- Take the bus n. **21** for "FRANCAVILLA FORO"

Or

- Take the bus for "ORTONA" and get off the bus in VIALE GUGLIELMO MARCONI 122 (10 min)
- The University will be a few minutes on foot from there.

FROM THE AIRPORT (PESCARA) TO THE UNIVERSITY IN CHIETI:

30 minutes:

- Walk from the airport to VIA TIBURTINA VALERIA (bus stop 307)
- Take the bus for "CHIETI-VIA OSPEDALE-UNIVERSITÁ" and get off the bus in "UNIVERSITÁ DI CHIETI G.D'ANNUNZIO"
- The University will be a few minutes on foot from there.

FROM THE CENTRAL STATION (CHIETI) TO THE UNIVERSITY IN CHIETI:

15-30 minutes:

- Walk from the station to VIALE BENEDETTO CROCE (2 min)
- Take the bus n. **1** for "PIAZZALE S.ANNA OSPEDALE CLINICIZZATO-UNIVERSITÁ" and get off the bus in UNIVERSITÁ G.D'ANNUNZIO CAMPUS DI CHIETI
- The University will be a few minutes on foot from there.

Or

- Walk from the station to VIA COLONNETTA
- Take the bus n. 31 for "SAN MARTINO" and get off the bus in "VIA PESCARA 132"
- The University will be a few minutes on foot from there.

Or

- Walk from the station to VIA PALIZZI 10
- Take the bus n. **1/** for "PIAZZALE MARTIRI PENNESI" and get off the bus in VIA COLLE DELL'ARA
- The University will be a few minutes on foot from there.

Anyway, we suggest to download two useful apps: Google Maps and Moovit!

GENERAL INFO 6

Incoming students Procedure

BEFORE ARRIVAL

Ensure that you have completed the Application Form and emailed the Learning Agreement with signatures on these documents (student signature, home university and receiving), to the incoming@unich.it email address

UPON YOUR ARRIVAL

Once you have reached Chieti or Pescara, inform the Erasmus office and ask for the certificate of arrival (Saturdays and Sundays will not be taken into account, as they're not working days. The certificate will be issued indicating your day of arrival as Monday.)

DURING YOUR STAY

If you need to change one or more subjects that you do not like or do not fit your program, you can change those subjects.

Deadlines:

- First semester: November 30th
- Second Semester: February 28th

Students that, during the mobility, decide to extend it, must provide the extension certificate 30 days before the end of their stay.

The rules are applied to both, 1st and 2nd semester.

UPON YOUR DEPARTURE

Ask for the End of Stay Certificate indicating the date of your departure (make sure the date doesn't match up with weekends) and the Transcript of Records (make sure all grades have been uploaded to your personal page).

NOTES

While applying to lectures and exams, make sure that the subject's name, code and CFU match those in your Learning Agreement. The CFU's reported will be those indicated by the professor, not those shown in your Learning Agreement.

OPENING AND CLOSING OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR


The beginning of the academic year is scheduled for **October 1st** and the end on **September 30th**.

Credit system & Exams



The Italian university system for the bachelor program is made of a total of 180 CREDITI FORMATIVI UNIVERSITARI (CFU) that the students have to collect to get a degree. As regarding the voting of every single exam, the scale goes from the mark 0 to the mark 30 with also the possibility to get 30 CUM LAUDE. The minimum to pass an exam is 18.

INSTRUCTIONS OF HOW TO REGISTER FOR EXAMS:

In order to register for the exams there are two different ways:

- through the online Ud'A platform: https://unich.esse3.cineca.it
- by downloading for free the app called "**Ud'A**" that you can easily find in the Play Store or in the App Store

1st method: Website


- 1 Click on the **Menu** that is represented by the 3 bars in the upper right corner; If you did not receive the password or the matriculation number, please send an email to incoming@unich.it
- 2 **Log in** using as username the matriculation number and the password received by email; (*Example: username: 3628457; Password: 2SYHYOKE*)
- 3 Then click on "**Exams**", then "**Exam session**" and you will get a list with all the subject and their exam's days. In this table is indicated, the name of the subject, the day of the exam and the available time in which you can register for the exam. In the left colon of this table, you will find either a red ban symbol or a blue symbol of a book. The exam is available for the booking only if there is a blue symbol;
- 4 In order to complete the booking, click on the blue symbol, then on **reserve** and then on the word in blue "**Click Here**";

5 - On this page you have to fill in a survey: click the **red symbol** on the right-hand side of the table line. Once the survey is filled in, it must be confirmed and then you can proceed with the reservation.

2nd method: App

- 1 **Open** the application called "Ud'A", **Log in** using as username the matriculation number and the password received by email; (*Example: username: 3628457; Password: 2SYHYOKE*)
- 2 Tap on the icon **Questionnaires**, which is linked to your subject's exams, and afterwards fill it in. Once you have completed it, you have to confirm it.
- 3 By selecting the icon with the text "**Exams Calendar**" you will be able to have a look at the courses that you have decided to attend in your Learning Agreement (LA)
- 4 Then in column "Bookable" click on your subject's exams and later on the day you want to book the exam. If they are available for the booking, you will be shown a green icon. Lastly you have to click on "**Subscribe**".

PAY ATTENTION: Before you register for the exam, make sure that the professor's name is matching yours, otherwise you have to send an email explaining the problem in details: the professor's name, the name of the graduation course and the name of the followed lesson.

1^ RANGE: INCLUDES THE COST OF €, 2.00 PER MEAL

2^ RANGE: INCLUDES THE COST OF €. 3.30 AT MEAL

Erasmus students are automatically included in the 2nd range.

PROCEDURE IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE 2nd RANGE APPLICATION:

- 1 Connect to the website <u>www.adsuchietipescara.it</u> and follow the path below on the home page of the website: SPORTELLO ONLINE
- 2 ACCREDITATION: enter your data and fill in the online pages until confirmed;
- 3 LOGIN: enter the Canteen Request section and enter the requested data on each page up to the CONFIRM box which must be selected in order to proceed the application to this ADSU;

Students who do not intend to enter their ISEE values in the application (because they are higher than the indicated limit or because they do not match the merit requirements) on the online application page relating to the allocation of the bracket, can select YES under the item: "The undersigned DOES NOT declare own merit and income data and therefore requests to be placed in LEVEL II provided for access to the canteen at the cost of EURO 3.30 per meal". By clicking YES, the student will not be asked for data on merit and income, with the consequent attribution of the 2nd RANGE.

Erasmus students will have to fill in the application for access to the catering service according to the following procedure:



Residence permit



IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

European citizens (coming from countries that belong to the European Union) from April, 11th 2007 are not required to apply for the residence permit.

They must register at the registration office (l'ufficio dell'**Anagrafe**) of the town of residence, showing that their stay in Italy will last longer than 3 months.

They have to provide the Anagrafe office with an "autocertificazione" (self declaration) attesting the enrollment in Università Gabriele d'Annunzio, a statement concerning the **income** and a valid **health insurance**.

NON-EU CITIZENS - RESIDENCE PERMIT

The Italian law on immigration requires that non-EU citizens, planning to stay in Italy for more than 3 months, have to apply for the **residence permit** within 8 working days from their arrival in Italy.

People with dual nationality (Italian or EU/ExtraEU) do not need to apply for the residence permit.

Non-EU citizens have to submit the residence permit application at any post office where there is a "Sportello Amico" counter.

You can also receive assistance at any Patronato office.

DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT FOR THE APPLICATION:

- Application form correctly filled in and signed from the concerned person.
- Passport, or equivalent travel document, still valid with a Visa for entry attached.
- Photocopy of the full Passport.
- Attestation certifying the course of study in the Receiving University with the Visa released by the Italian Diplomatic/Consular Mission upon issuance of the entry Visa.
- Photocopy of the insurance policy, valid in the national territory, for the period of validity of the residence permit, against the risk of sickness or injury.
- 4 passport-size photos, recent and identical.
- Stamp duty of € 16,00.
- Receipt of payment of € 30,46 and € 30,00 for the delivery service of the practice via Poste Italiane.
- Rental agreement or declaration of hospitality accompanied by an identity document of the host person.
- Economic Certification: foreigners who intend to come to Italy for study must demonstrate that they have sufficient resources to ensure their subsistence during the planned stay.

The economic availability can be demonstrated by personal or economic guarantees provided by institutions and Italian organizations or foreign institutions and bodies considered as reliable by the Italian Diplomatic Authority (for example: bank c/c, bank guarantees, bank or insurance guarantee policies, etc...).

THE PROCEDURE

- a) Find the forms you need.
- b) Submit the Application.

Forms can be found in the special kit available in every "Poste Italiane" office. Forms must be filled in capital letters, with a black pen and within the appropriate spaces.

c) Photo-reporting.

The request must be submitted by the person concerned in an open envelope at the post offices. At the time of submission of the request at the post office enabled, the foreigner will be identified with a Passport or other equivalent document.

The Poste Italiane operator will deliver the foreigner:

- Proof of Registration Letter to be kept. On the receipt there are two personal identification codes (user id and password) through which the applicant can check the status of the practice by connecting to www.portaleimmigrazione.it or check on the website of the Questura if the residence permit is ready for collection.

The meeting day in the Questura, the student must have the following documents:

- 4 passport-size photos (white background).
- Copy of documents sent with the kit.
- Passport (original).
- Receipt of the Registered Letter (Raccomandata) of the kit.
- The communication of the date on which the foreigner must appear to Questura for the photoreporting 4 photos and a further copy of the documents already sent in the kit and will be delivered by the foreigner, who will also be fingerprinted.

- Stamp Duty of € 16,00, you can buy it at the Tobacconist's (Tabacchi shop);
- € 30,46 for the issuing of the electronic residence permit valid for 1 year.
- € 30,00 to pay via Poste Italiane (cost of the service) at the moment of the sending.

Guide to the tax code (Fiscal Code)



The Fiscal Code (Codice Fiscale) is a code made of letters and numbers on the basis of your first name, family name, date and place of birth and it is used by the Public Administration to identify the citizens living in Italy. All those living in Italy need to have their own.

It is possible to receive it at the local Revenue Agency (Uffici Locali dell'Agenzia delle Entrate), bringing along the passport / Identity Card.

The Revenue Agencies in Pescara is located in: P.zza Italia, 15 65121, Pescara

They will give you a module to sign and you will receive a copy of your FISCAL CODE/CODICE FISCALE.

The Fiscal Code is necessary, to apply for the residence permit, to sign the leasing contract, to open a bank account, to enter into a tenancy agreement, to receive medical care attention, to earn a salary and carry out other procedures/activities. If the Codice Fiscale gets lost or stolen, a duplicate can be requested at the local Revenue Agency.

PAY ATTENTION: Non-European students MUST bring along the passport

In order to have the Fiscal Code is necessary to reserve an appointment at the <u>Agenzia delle</u> <u>Entrate</u>

You could follow <u>this tutorial</u> to book an appointment. **We clarify that we are not linked to this person. So please don't contact him to get help**. Only follow the tutorial and if you need contact the ESN Chieti Pescara!

PAY ATTENTION: Non-European students with a second European citizenship: for the Italian law, the European citizenship prevails on the non-European one. Therefore, the Fiscal Code will be done according to the name/s on the European passport.

Health insurance

EU CITIZENS

Students from the European Union member countries, who upon the arrival have the TEAM card or the E106 Form (statement of the original European Health Card issued by their country), can have access to the same services as the Italian citizens, offered by the Italian National Health Service (SSN).

The assistance of a family doctor is guaranteed if you have an ID card (identity card) and the original European Health Card (TEAM) or a substitutive statement (Modello E106). In this case it is possible to go directly to a family doctor affiliated with the National Health Service, both for health problems and/or to ask for medical prescriptions. The ASL (Local Health Authority) will request the reimbursement to the competent foreign institution, according to the rules of the National Health Service of the country of provenance of the student.

NON-EU CITIZENS

The immigration law requires you to take out a health insurance during your stay in Italy.

- If you take out a private insurance in your country, please remember that, in order to be valid in Italy for obtaining the residence permit, it needs to have the following requirements:
- it has to be taken out in the holder's name (in western characters)
- it has to be written in Italian (or in English, French, Spanish)
- validity in the Schengen Area/Italy
- it states the exact coverage period (it must be not less than 6 months and maximum 1 year; notice that the duration of the residence permit will be connected to the duration of the insurance)
- it must be clearly written the type of coverage for the medical expenses and it must have
 € 30.000 ceiling (expressed/converted in Euros)
- The whole document has to be endorsed and stamped by the Italian Embassy/Consulate in your country.
- As an alternative, once in Italy you can take out a private insurance through an Italian insurance company, that will cover urgent medical assistance (surgery and accidents) in the Emergency Room (Pronto Soccorso) of any hospital.
- Otherwise, upon arrival, it is possible to subscribe to the Italian National Health Service (Servizio Sanitario Nazionale S.S.N.). Nowadays, the price for students is € 149,77 a year; the payment is valid for a calendar year, that is, until the 31st of December of the year when the payment has been made. In order to subscribe, first you have to pay € 149,77 at any post office, by filling in the F24 form (MODELLO F24). After submitting your residence permit application, you have to go to the A.S.L. office in the area where you live (A.S.L. are the local administrative and operative facilities of the National Health Service) and apply for the subscription, bringing along: your passport, the residence permit receipt, the payment receipt of MODELLO F24.

The public coverage supplied by the National Health Service (Servizio Sanitario Nazionale) provides full health assistance - including the possibility to choose a family doctor. In the Italian health system, the family doctor gives general or 1st level health assistance, that is health care outside the hospital, hence including medical treatment in case of ordinary diseases or no-emergency health problems, and prescribes medicines and tests.

- Information about the public health assistance is available here
- Lastly, those who have a document proving their right to health assistance on the basis of treaties and bilateral agreements signed by Italy and one's own Country, which has been issued by the Italian Embassy/Consulate in their Country, can show this document to make use of the health services stated in the agreement. For more information, it is necessary to apply to the A.S.L. in the area of residence.

If you temporarily move, are you eligible to ask for health care in your new address? How can you ask for a GP (general practitioner) temporarily?

In this case, you are eligible to temporarily health care for people who are temporary residents, even if you need the necessary documentation. For people who change their address for work related reasons, for study or for medical treatments, it's necessary to choose a GP (general practitioner) where these people move temporarily. In addition, the stay in the new address has to be from 3 months to 1 year. After 1 year, if you need to stay longer, you can ask to be enrolled for another 12 months, and you have to present the necessary documentation. If you need access to health care you need to enroll in Servizio Sanitario Nazionale (SSN) both if you are an Italian citizen and if you are a migrant to Italy with permanent residence. For this, you have to go to the medical center of your area.

The documents you need are:

- Your ID
- Codice fiscale
- Permanent residence certificate

If you are enrolled in the Servizio Sanitario you have the right to request a GP (general practitioner), a pediatrician etc.

You need to show your Codice Fiscale everytime you need to receive medical care and social care as well as if you need medications.

If you need emergency care you can go to the emergency unit of the hospital in your area.

HOW TO CHOOSE A TEMPORARY DOCTOR:

To choose a temporary doctor you need to go to your ASL to ask for the temporary cancellation of this service. After the cancellation, you need to go need to bring your medicare, your ID and documents related to your moving. Then you need to fill in a form that you can download from the Azienda Sanitaria Locale.

In the form for the choice of your GP (general practitioner) you need to give:

- your personal data with address and address and phone number
- the declaration of your new address
- the reason why you are asking for temporary health care
- the date and the signature of the interested person

The main line in transport to and from Pescara and Chieti is managed by TUA (<u>Trasporto Unico Abruzzese</u>), to which both wheeled and rail transport are entrusted. <u>Trenitalia Lines</u>: Teramo - Giulianova - Pescara centrale - Pescara Porta Nuova - Chieti - Madonna delle Piane - Chieti Staz. Centrale. To reach the university building of Chieti, you shall step out of the train at the station called <u>Madonna delle Piane</u>.


