- **Scientific appointments:** The research activity in the context of Molecular Biology will focus on the molecular, genetics, and epigenetics mechanisms in neoplastic diseases as the Hepatocarcinoma, Breast cancer, Colorectal carcinoma, Paraganglioma, and Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia. Mainly the research will be performed through in vitro and in vivo models, to unravel the relationship between genetic and epigenetic aberration;
- **Rights and obligations:** as provided for by the provisions of the law concerning the legal status of the university researcher with a fixed term and the University's current code of ethics;
- **Duration:** 36 months and may be renewed for only for two years upon the actual procurement of the necessary economic resources;
- **Salary:** is equal to € 34,898.06 including tax and the thirteenth monthly salary for the duration of the contract. Corresponding to the salary due to the confirmed permanent researcher class 0, with a full-time commitment regime (beyond the increases referred to in the Prime Ministerial Decree of 03/09/2019);
- **Maximum number of publications:** n. 12 (twelve);
